The School Counselor you are writing about must be a certified School Counselor and be currently employed as a School Counselor in Pennsylvania.

Final selection will be made by May 9, 2016. Announcement of the recipient will be made at the recipient's high school. Payment of the scholarship will be made directly to the post-secondary institution upon written verification of the student's enrollment.

The format of the application form may not be changed in any way.

All materials submitted shall become the property of the PSCA.
