

**Peanut Butter Cookie Recipe** $\frac{3}{4}$  cup peanut butter $\frac{1}{2}$  cup vegetable shortening $\frac{5}{4}$  cup brown sugar

3 tablespoons milk

 $\frac{11}{4}$  teaspoons vanilla extract

1 large egg

 $\frac{3}{2}$  cups flour $\frac{3}{4}$  teaspoon baking soda $\frac{1}{4}$  teaspoon salt**Makes 2 dozen (24) cookies****Serving size:  $1\frac{1}{2}$  cookies**

- 1.) Caroline wants to make these cookies to bring to a party. She will need to **double** the recipe to have enough. How much of each ingredient will she need? Rewrite the recipe for Caroline so that the given amounts will make enough cookies for the party. Show your work.

- 2.) Everyone loved Caroline's cookies so much that they ate them all! She wants to make some more to eat at home, but would only like to make 1 dozen cookies, which is *half* of the amount that the original recipe makes. How much of each ingredient will she need? Rewrite the recipe so that it will only make 1 dozen cookies. Show your work.
