## Text Dependent Analysis Essays- TDA

#### What is it?

- It is an essay, so it has an: introduction, paragraphs of support, and conclusion.
- But it is text dependent. This means that you must support your ideas with specific details from the text.
- Requires students to provide <u>explicit</u> and <u>implicit evidence</u> from the text and to <u>draw</u> <u>inferences</u> based on what the text says in order to <u>support an analysis</u>.

Must be written in 3<sup>rd</sup> person point of view. Don't use the pronoun I.

#### INTRODUCTION

- Start with a lead that briefly <u>summarizes</u> what you have read. (1-2 sentences)
- Write your thesis. Your thesis restates the prompt with your response. (1 sentence)



# 1st PARAGRAPH OF SUPPORT/ 1st EXPLANATION

- Explain the first point from your thesis. Make sure your explanation is FIT!
- 6-8 sentences



### 2nd PARAGRAPH OF SUPPORT/ 2nd EXPLANATION

- Explain the second point from your thesis. Make sure your explanation is FIT!
- 6-8 sentences



# 3rd PARAGRAPH OF SUPPORT/ 3RD EXPLANATION

- Explain the third point from your thesis. Make sure your explanation is FIT!
- 6-8 sentences



### CONCLUSION

- Restate your thesis. (1 sentence)
- Leave the reader with some thought to consider. (1-2 sentences)
