Monday November 4

Objective- SW- explore the key idea of similarities/SW- analyze mood, tone and style/SW- define vocabulary words/SW- read a short story-"The All American Slurp"/SW- recite poetry- "The Turkey Shot Out of the Oven"

Procedure-

- Read "Hoot"
- Recite "The Turkey Shot Out of the Oven" poetry recital for November
- "The All -American Slurp"-IR pg. 68- students will write in notebooks any similarities, any differences??? Discuss
- Show the transparency that matches the IR pg. 69/Discuss findings
- IR pg. 70 Take notes on mood, tone and style
- Use sheet 31 to introduce the vocabulary words
