- Japan invades Pearl Harbor—Dec. 7, 1941
- US declares war on Japan & Germany—Dec. 8
- VE Day—May 8, 1945
- Victory in Japan after "Little Boy" and "Fat Man" were dropped on Hiroshima & Nagasaki—Aug. 6 & 9, 1945

**Chapter 28: The Cold War--1945-1960** 

**Section 1: Healing the Wounds of War** 

### **Occupation Rule**

- Germany & Japan were shattered--rebuilding countries would be monumental task
- Potsdam Conference: US, France, UK, USSR all split Germany into 4 zones (Berlin as well)
- Crushed all remaining elements of Nazi Party
- USSR's behavior was concerning
- US occupied Japan from 1945-1952
- We demilitarized Japan & created democracy w/ US ideals--Emperor Hirohito became figurehead
- Allowed labor unions & broke up zaibatsu (large family-run monopolies--like pre-Civil War plantations)
- Gen. Douglas MacArthur ran the country





#### The War Crimes Trials

- Nuremberg Trials: international court in Nuremberg, Germany
  - 1946: 12 Nazis sentenced to death, 7 sent to jail, and 3 found not guilty
  - Hundreds of other trials that led to jail, fines, barring from public office
  - Many Nazis fled to Latin America
- Tokyo Trials: 7 people, including Premier Hideki Tojo, sentenced to death
- Precedent was set that there are "rules of war"--certain activities such as torture and using the argument "I was simply following orders" is unacceptable



#### The United Nations

- April 1945: Founded in San Francisco
- Goal is to fight for world peace
- 50 nations originally joined (193 today)
- Security Council: 5 permanent members (US, USSR, UK, France, China) & 10 rotating members
  - Make all military decisions & can veto any votes
- Headquarters are in New York City
- Former First Lady Eleanor Roosevelt was one of first US delegates
- Question became whether UN was powerful enough to enforce its rules





## The Founding of Israel

- First test for UN--what to do with Palestine
- Many European Jews fled to Holy Land--Arabs protested
- UK ruled Palestine--gave authority to UN b/c the problem was too big for them
- UN created 2 states--1 for Jews and 1 for Arabs
- Zionism: movement to create a Jewish homeland
- 1948: Israel was officially organized--US & USSR recognized it
- Arab-Israeli War: violent reaction from Arab states
  - Egypt, Iraq, Lebanon, Syria, Transjordan all wanted Jews out
  - Jews were outnumbered but had advantage w/ weapons bought from \$ sent in by American Jews
  - 1949: agreement gave more land to Israel & split Jerusalem into Arab & Israeli zones





# **Section 2: The Cold War Begins**


The Roots of the Cold War

Cold War: ever present threat of war between US & USSR

United States' values: democratic gov't, individual freedoms, capitalism

Soviet Unions' values: single-party rule, suppression o religion & freedoms, state-run economy (**socialism**)

- USSR led by Joseph Stalin during/after WWII
- Stalin pushed to create satellite nations through Europe
  - Estonia, Latvia, Lithuania, Poland, Romania, Manchuria
- Led to US efforts of containment of the "Iron Curtain"



# **Deadlock over Atomic Weapons**

- USSR began developing nuclear weapons after WWII
- Led to disputes between US & USSR
- Baruch Plan: American plan to create international agency to inspect nuclear powers to ensure rules are followed--USSR rejected it
- 1949: USSR tested 1st atomic bomb--nuclear arms race becomes real


#### Containment Around the World

- Containment policy required money, supplies, and sometimes soldiers to stop spread of Communism
- Truman Doctrine: "policy...to support free peoples who are resisting..." Communism & USSR
  - Gave \$400 million of aid for Greece & Turkey to fight Communist rebels
  - Marshall Plan: \$17 billion program to give aid to European countries suffering from Depression and rebuilding efforts after WWII
    - Fear was USSR would have too much influence on Europe



#### Crisis in Berlin

- US, UK, France combined their sections of Germany in 1948--USSR kept East Germany
- Capital of Berlin sat in East Germany--split in same way as Germany
- West Berlin became a way for people to flee East Germany--angered USSR
- June 24, 1948: Soviets blocked all roads and travel in/out of West Berlin--no food, fuel, etc. going into city
- Soviet attempt to take the whole city
- Berlin Airlift: 10 months of airlifts dropped food/supplies into city--became lifeline
  - - Soviets eventually lifted to blockade




■ Warsaw Pact: 1955 Soviet response to NATO



#### **Section 3: The Cold War Turns Hot**

## Communist Victory in China

- 1920s: Civil War in China between democratic gov't
   & Communist-inspired students
- Civil War halted during WWII
- Mao Zedong: Communist leader after WWII continued Civil War--took land from wealthy & gave it to peasants
- We gave aid to democratic gov't/soldiers
- 1949: democratic gov't & army fled China for island of Taiwan
  - 2 Chinas:
    - Taiwan: democratic China
    - China: People's Republic (Communist)
    - We only recognized Taiwanese China







- Japan ruled Korea until WWII--we split Korea w/ USSR
- 1948: North Korea & South Korea permanently created
- Kim II Sung: 1st dictator & grandfather of current dictator (Kim Jong Un)
- US propped up South Korea to make it strong against North
- USSR propped up North
- 1949: US & USSR both left Korea
- June 25, 1950: North Korea invades South Korea
- UN sent soldiers in to stop North aggression
- Douglas MacArthur was head of US & UN troops
- North overruns nearly who country by Sept.
- Sept. 1950: MacArthur launches counterattack--pushed the North back to almost China
- Nov. 1950: China sends 300,000 troops & pushes UN back to 38th parallel



## **Ending the Korean War**

- MacArthur butted heads w/ Truman
  - Wanted to invade China but Truman worried USSR would then get into fight--didn't want WWIII
  - Also wanted to use nuclear weapons--Truman didn't
- Truman removed MacArthur--Truman became unpopular
- Gen. Dwight Eisenhower ran and easily won election as POTUS in 1952 against Adlai Stevenson ("egghead")
- Eisenhower promised to be tough against Communism
- Ended war w/ increased bombings to convince North to negotiate peace treaty
- July 27, 1953: amistice is signed--doesn't end war
  - maintained virtually same border
  - 54,000 dead US
  - 1.3 million Koreans & Chinese dead





## Fighting Communism Abroad

- Eisenhower saw nuclear arms & technology as keys to winning Cold War
- Can't be afraid of war (brinkmanship)--take NOTHING off the table
- Used the new CIA to gather strategic information & start coups
- 1951: CIA led covert operation to replace Iranian leader--led to anti-American feelings in Iran
- 1955: CIA bombed anti-American gov't in Guatemala-increased anger towards US in Latin America
- Increased aid to Middle East countries to resist Communism
- Suez Crisis: brink of war between USSR & west over access to oil
- 1956: Hungarian uprising--martial law declared & dissidents arrested/executed
  - Eisenhower condemned Soviet actions but refused to help too much for fear of nuclear war



#### A Brief Thaw in the Cold War

- Attempts made to improve relationship
- 1959: VP Richard Nixon visits USSR
   USSR leader Nikita Khrushchev visited Iowa, Pittsburgh, Hollywood-things looked good
- May 1960: American U2 spyplane shot down in USSR
  - Gary Powers admitted to spying mission
- Khrushchev demanded apology--lke refused
- Ended any chance at continued thaw



#### Section 4: The Cold War at Home

#### Cold War Fears

- Fear of war w/ USSR caused:
  - Creation of CIA
  - Replaced Dept. of War w/ Dept. of Defense
  - Created National Security Council to advise POTUS on all military/political info from around world
- Fear of Communism at home
  - Federal employees investigated by "loyalty boards"--led to 2,000 resignations & 300 firings
  - House Un-American Activities Committee (HUAC) created in House of Reps

    - Investigated ties to Communism--focus on labor unions & Hollywood
      - Hollywood Ten: 10 directors/writers that went to jail rather than answer questions of HUAC
  - Investigations & "witch hunts" led to **blacklists** in many industries
- Julius & Ethel Rosenberg: found guilty & executed of providing nuclear secrets to USSR



# **McCarthyism**

- Joseph McCarthy: US Senator from Wisconsin
- Claimed to have a list of known Communist sympathizers in the US
- Used his power on Senate to investigate anyone he wanted
- Mere mention of your name by him would ruin your career/reputation
- Few challenged him due to fear of being labeled a Communist
- Used public opinion well
- Army-McCarthy Hearings:
  - 35 days of televised hearings of members of Army
  - Bullied & harrassed soldiers & officers
  - Found no evidence of Communism in Army
  - "Have you no sense of decency, sir?"
  - Lost public support
  - Eventually punished by Senate for conduct



# **Nuclear Anxiety**

 Arms race led to US developing hydrogen bomb (1000x stronger than atomic bomb)



- 1st test of H-bomb vaporized an entire island in South Pacific
- USSR developed H-bomb
- Real fear of Americans led to increased church attendance-also led to differentiation w/ atheist USSR
  - added "one nation under God" to Pledge
- Protocols developed nationwide concerning what to do in event of nuclear war
- Fall out shelters dug all over country
- Companies specialized in building them
- Nuclear arms race spread to space
  - Oct. 1957: USSR launches Sputnik
  - Sputnik II had a dog on board--only lived a few days of 200 day mission
  - 1958: US sent 1st satellite (Explorer I)
  - National Aeronautics and Space Administration
     (NASA) & National Defense Education Act to increase funding for math & science education
