Commas with Dates and Places



A comma is used to separate the date from the year when writing a date. Commas are also used to separate the name of a city from a state or country.

Examples: Karen ate 12 bowls of Sugar Puffs on June 23, 2009.

James went to Seattle, Washington to do his laundry.
