Introduction


With the implementation of Act 35 of 2018 in the 2020-21 school year, LEAs are responsible for completing an annual survey to capture the following:

- Type of the assessment of civics knowledge administered
- Total number of students who took the assessment
- Total number of students who attained a passing grade on the assessment
- Grade level or levels in which the assessment was administered
- Course or course in which the assessment was administered
- Number of students scoring 100% on the assessment

Accessing and Completing the Survey

The survey is housed in the Future Ready Comprehensive Planning Portal system and is available on November 15, with a reporting deadline of January 7, 2022.

- The LEA's Local User Administrator must grant access to the survey.
 - ✓ If you do not have access to the FRCPP, <u>this link</u> provides you with instructions on how to register for the FRCPP application in MYPDESuite.
 - ✓ If you are registered for the FRCPP as a Local User, someone at your LEA with Local User Administration rights will then need to add the Act 35 report to your account.
- Once logged into the FRCPP, click on "State Required Reports" and scroll to the Act 35 reporting link to complete the survey.
