- Inventory is based on Pennsylvania's Learning Standards for Early Childhood.
- Includes 30 standards-based indicators and reports data in the domains of: Social and Emotional Development; English Language Arts; Mathematics; Approaches to Learning through Play; and Health, Wellness and Physical Development.
- Kindergarten Entry Inventory is intended to be used by kindergarten teachers to record students' demonstration of skills within the first 45 calendar days of the kindergarten year.
